APPROVED SELECTBOARD SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES  
February 22, 2016  
Danville Town Hall (7:00 PM)

**CALL TO ORDER**

Michael Walsh, Chair, called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM, announcing that this was a special budget hearing meeting.

**BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT**

Michael Walsh, Doug Pastula, Ken Linsley, Angelo Incerpi.

**ALSO PRESENT**

Keith Gadapee, Barb and Gary Fontaine, Virginia Incerpi, Tim Ide, Darlene Lynch.

- Michael Walsh began the meeting by reviewing the General Fund Budget.
  - He asked if there were any comments from those present. There were none.
  - He stated that the town did not receive funds from the railroad station restoration grant applied for in October, and we will apply for that again this year.
- Michael then reviewed the Highway Fund Budget.
  - He asked if there were any comments:
    - Barb Fontaine asked where the paving grant funds would be used.
    - Keith Gadapee replied that it would be used on a portion of Bruce Badger Memorial Highway.
- Michael then asked if there were any other comments or questions:
  - Tim Ide asked who would be running for Selectboard this year.
    - Michael replied that three positions were up for re-election: (Craig Vance, Doug Pastula and Ken Linsley).
    - Doug and Ken both indicated that they were interested in running for re-election.
    - The consensus was that Craig had also expressed interest in running for re-election.
  - Doug Pastula made the motion to hire Marcia Pettigrew to assist Mary in the Selectboard office for up to five hours per week as needed at her same rate of pay. Angelo Incerpi seconded the motion.
    - Doug explained that Marcia had expressed an interest in working more hours, was already employed by the town as a lister, and Mary is in need of assistance with more clerical duties associated with her position.
    - Ken explained that the money has already been budgeted for this purpose and that it would not be taken out of the listers' budget. All in favor.

At 7:19 PM Ken Linsley made the motion to adjourn. Doug Pastula seconded the motion. All in favor.
