

HEARING NOTICE FOR DANVILLE RESIDENTS

The Danville Planning Commission, in accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 4444, will hold a hearing on a proposed amendment to the Zoning Bylaw on Thursday, December 14, beginning at 7:30 p.m. in the Town Hall. All Danville community members are invited to attend to review the proposed bylaw amendment, which clarifies definitions, products, and processes involved in subdivisions and adds standards and a permitting process for signs.

The Zoning Bylaw provides for orderly community growth, encourages appropriate development in accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 4302, and implements the intent of the Danville Town Plan. The proposed amendment affects the following sections: 205, Application of District Regulations; 302, Required Frontage on, or Access to, public Roads or Public Waters; 702, Definitions; and 806, Subdivisions of Land; and adds a new section 314, Signs.
