BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY MINUTES  
FEBRUARY 24, 2016

The Board of Civil Authority met at 4:32 p.m. at the Danville Town Clerk's office on February 24, 2016 for the purpose of approving the minutes of the 2/25/2015 meeting, minutes of the 2/25/15 Abatement Hearings, electing a Chairman of BCA, electing a Vice-Chairman of BCA, designating a polling place for the annual Town and School District meeting and the NEKWM Budget vote, appointing a presiding officer and election officials for Town Meeting, review voter checklist for additions, deletions & challenges, and appointment of Justices for delivery of ballots.
