APPROVED SELECTBOARD SITE VISIT AND PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
August 18, 2016
Danville Town Hall

CALL TO ORDER

At 5:00 PM, Michael Walsh, Chair, called the meeting to order for the purpose of performing a site visit to Clark Road, to be followed by a 7:00 PM Public Hearing to hear testimony regarding reclassifying a 700-foot portion of Clark Road from Class IV to Class III that would be maintained by the Town upon completion.

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT:

The board members proceeded to Clark Road for the site visit.

They returned at 5:55 PM.

At 6:00 PM Michael Walsh asked for a motion to adjourn the site visit.

- *A motion was made by Doug Pastula and seconded by Ken Linsley to adjourn the site visit and reconvene for the public hearing at 7:00 PM tonight so the regular Selectboard meeting could begin at 6:00. All in favor.*

(Regular Selectboard meeting underway from 6:00 PM to to 7:05 PM)

At 7:05 PM Michael Walsh called the public hearing to order to hear testimony regarding reclassifying a 700-foot portion of Clark Road from Class IV to Class III that would be maintained by the Town upon completion.

- The board reported on the site visit and stated that the road would require much maintenance and expressed danger concerns getting a 10-wheeler down the road and back out in the winter months.
- Jay Dege, resident of Clark Road, stated that his kids needed to be able to get to school.
- Michael Walsh spoke about it being easier for emergency services to respond.

After discussion, and a reminder to the board that it needed to be clearly demonstrated how reclassifying this portion of the road serves the general public, a vote was taken.

- *A motion was made by Doug Pastula and seconded by Angelo Incerpi to not reclassify the 700' section of Clark Road being discussed from Class IV to Class III at this time. The motion passed 3-2.*

At 7:43 PM Ken Linsley made the motion to adjourn the special hearing for Clark Road Reclassification discussion and reconvene the regular Selectboard meeting. The motion was seconded by Ken Linsley. All in favor.
