Agenda - Sunday, December 3, 2017 at 10:00 AM

The Danville Conservation Commission will meet at the Rodger Lot Town Forest by the wood dump at 10:00 AM on Sunday, December 3.

1. The purpose of the meeting is to locate and flag the area near the wood dump where Japanese Knotweed is growing. This is for the purpose of determining a means of eradication of this invasive plant.
2. The three means of eradication include (a) continuous cutting, (b) covering with black plastic, or (c) use of pesticides. There is a possibility that the area could be divided into 3 experimental plots to see which method works best. School groups could be involved with treating and/or monitoring the results.
3. The Commission also plans to walk through the red pine stands which are scheduled for thinning/maintenance for forest improvement and release of the hardwood understory. County Forester, Matt Langlais will be selecting and marking trees next spring.
4. Approval of the notes from the November 6 meeting.
