Danville Recycling Center

At this time the Danville recycling center is open Saturdays 8am – noon, with the following protocols in place. The number of people allowed into the Recycling Center at any given time will be 1-3 depending on the discretion of the operator, Bob LaRose in accordance with the most recent CDC guidelines. All customers will enter through one door and exit through a different door to minimize encounters in the doorway. If at any time it appears that people cannot maintain the 6' distance despite these protocols the center will be shut down until further notice. Please be patient while waiting for your neighbors to recycle.
