A Permit is required for any "development" defined as but not limited to a subdivision of a parcel of land into 2 or more parcels of land, the construction, reconstruction, conversion, demolition, structural alteration, relocation, enlargement or addition to any building or structure, or extension of use of land.

### **Important: A Certificate of Compliance will be required for all permits**

To help me better serve you, please PRINT clearly. An incomplete or illegible form can delay the permit process. Please submit the completed Zoning Application with the applicable fee in an envelope labelled 'Zoning'. Checks are to be made payable to the Town of Danville.

If you have questions or need assistance in completing your application, please contact me.
